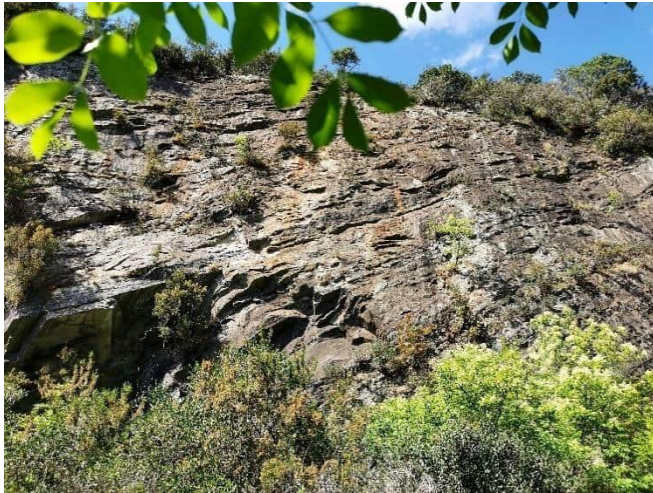


“Monte Serra” Tectonic Unit
Formazione delle Quarziti del Monte Serra - Membro delle Quarziti Bianco-Rosa (QMS3)

Outcrop in the Agnano quarry on the right side of the
“Valle della Polla”..



Upper portion of Quarziti bianco-rosa member. Monotonous succession of coarsely layered dark grey quartzite in centimetre-thick levels. Diffuse occurrence of ripple marks, load casts, mud cracks and less frequent fossil traces consisting of saurian footprints.

Non-foliated fine-grained equigranular quartzite. On the layer surface fossil traces such as: mud cracks (red arrow) and probable saurian footprints (white arrow) are visible.
